## Ice Cream Book Report

Using the paper that I gave you, create an ice cream cone to describe your favorite book that you have ever read.

## Steps to complete project:

- 1. After reading the book, complete each scoop of ice cream. Write two sentences for each of the beginning, middle and end scoop. For the characters and setting, you may make a list or you may write them in sentence form.
- 2. Color each piece of the book report lightly in any color crayon, twistable crayon, or colored pencils. (NO MARKERS)
- 3. Cut out all pieces of the book report and glue or tape them together.
- 4. Practice presenting "Ice Cream" to family so that you will be ready to present to the class.
- 5. Turn in on time and present to the class. Student's Work: Parents are allowed to assist children in collecting materials, and helping students come up with a plan for their projects. I would like for the MAJORITY of the work (artwork, writing) to be from the child. This is a chance for them to be creative and show me what who they are as readers.
